Known to many of us from our student days (& sometimes nights) in the White OR, Dr. Austen was the youngest Chief of Surgery in the hospital's history and a mentor to all who sought his advice for over 65 years. #### **IHP News**

The Fundraising Gala, the first in several years, was held in October. The event, for which the NAA had purchased five tickets, raised over \$300,000 for the school.

Led by an idea from our Professional Development Committee, the NAA made a \$3000 donation to the Ruth Sleeper Center at the IHP. The funds will be used in the students' public health course, "to develop standardized teaching materials for a diverse population."

The IHP and its President Paula Milone-Nuzzo, have been named one of the Top 100 Women-Led Businesses in Massachusetts by The Women's Edge and its partner, *The Boston Globe Magazine*. Factors that went into the evaluation included revenue, operating budget, governing board makeup, innovative projects, and workplace and management diversity. #### History/Archives News

A paper authored by Mary Larkin, Susan Fisher & Kenneth White was presented by Dr. White at the American Association for the History of Nursing annual meeting in September. It is titled, "From a One-Year Experiment to 150 Years of Nursing Education: Reflections on the Origins of the Massachusetts General Hospital School of Nursing." Using newly available content, it tells the as yet unpublished story of the genesis of the school's founding in 1872-3. Print publication in one of the nursing journals is being considered. This effort represents a new collaboration between the NAA and the IHP.

The Russell Museum has reopened to the public several days per week and resumed the wintertime monthly lectures, available either in person or on Zoom. They are free but registration is required. Upcoming on November 15 from 6-7pm is, "Examining CRISPR: The Power and Promise of a Gene Editing Tool," presented by Dr. Keith Joung, MGH Department of Pathology, from 6 to 7 pm.
